- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
- 5 21-25.5 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/21-25.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 21-25.5. Speech and language pathologist not</u>
- 8 "teacher".
- 9 <u>(a) The General Assembly recognizes that for some</u>
- 10 purposes of this Code, the term "teacher" is broadly defined
- 11 to include all school district employees regularly required
- 12 <u>to be certified under laws relating to the certification of</u>
- 13 <u>teachers</u>. The General Assembly also recognizes that (i) some
- 14 <u>school district employees regularly required to be certified</u>
- 15 by law do not "teach" in the more narrow sense of imparting
- 16 <u>information in a classroom or classroom-like setting</u>
- 17 <u>involving one or more students and (ii) the professional</u>
- 18 services performed and offered in school settings by some
- 19 <u>speech</u> and language pathologists are not reasonably regarded
- 20 <u>as falling within this more narrow understanding of the term</u>
- 21 <u>"teach".</u>
- 22 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code or
- 23 any other law to the contrary, a speech and language
- 24 pathologist who possesses a certificate under Article 21 of
- 25 <u>this Code shall neither be required to have an employment or</u>
- 26 <u>contractual relationship directly with the school district he</u>
- 27 <u>or she serves nor be prohibited from serving in a school</u>
- 28 <u>setting while employed by a person or entity other than a</u>
- 29 <u>school district if the speech and language pathologist</u>
- 30 <u>neither performs nor offers to perform any functions in the</u>
- 31 school setting that are within the narrow understanding of

- 2 <u>Section.</u>
- 3 (c) The State Board of Education may, in its discretion,
- 4 <u>adopt rules with respect to this Section.</u>
- 5 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
