- 9 (a) A person commits the offense of endangering the life
- 10 and health of an emergency service provider if an emergency

- 12 <u>disability</u>, or <u>disfigurement</u> as a result of entering a
- 13 <u>structure containing a clandestine drug laboratory designed</u>
- 14 or intended to produce an unlawful controlled substance or
- 15 <u>designed or intended to produce ingredients used in the</u>
- 16 <u>manufacture of an unlawful controlled substance.</u>
- 17 <u>(b) In this Section:</u>
- 18 <u>"Emergency service provider" means a peace officer, a</u>
