- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Antitrust Act is amended by
- 5 adding Section 3.1 as follows:
- 6 (740 ILCS 10/3.1 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 3.1. Cigarette manufacturers; handling of their</u>
- 8 <u>products by retailers.</u>
- 9 (a) It is a violation of this Act for any cigarette
- 10 manufacturer, directly or indirectly, by contract, agreement,
- 11 <u>or otherwise</u>, to:
- 12 (1) condition a retailer's receipt of consumer
- 13 <u>promotions or consumer price discounts on the retailer's</u>
- 14 <u>conduct or actions relating to the manufacturer's</u>
- products or the products of any other manufacturer,
- 16 <u>except for requirements that the retailer (i) provide the</u>
- 17 <u>promotion or discount to consumers and (ii) advertise and</u>
- display the promotion and the promoted or discounted
- 19 <u>product to consumers;</u>
- 20 (2) require or cause the retailer to allocate a
- 21 <u>specified percentage or fraction of the retailer's</u>
- 22 merchandising, stocking, display, shelf, or advertising
- 23 <u>space to the manufacturer;</u>
- 24 (3) prevent, restrict, or limit a retailer from
- 25 <u>stocking</u>, <u>advertising</u>, <u>displaying</u>, <u>or participating in a</u>
- 26 <u>program for another manufacturer's product;</u>
- 27 (4) prevent, restrict, or limit the retailer from
- 28 <u>determining the size or location of the space that the</u>

- 31 (5) require the retailer to raise its prices on or

- 3 (b) Any person who violates a provision of this Section
- 4 shall be subject to all remedies permissible for violation of

- 7 <u>Cigarette Tax Act apply to this Section.</u>
- 8 (d) This Section applies to any new contract or
- 9 agreement entered into or any existing contract or agreement
