- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
- 5 adding Section 12-13.3 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/12-13.3 new)
- 7 Sec. 12-13.3. Transitional jobs; pilot program. The
- 8 <u>Department of Human Services shall establish a pilot program</u>
- 9 to place hard-to-employ persons, including persons who have
- 10 been released from a county jail or a facility under the
- 11 jurisdiction of the Department of Corrections, in jobs. By
- 12 rule, the Department shall determine the location in which
- the pilot program is to be implemented and the services to be
- 14 provided. The Department may consult with the Department of
- 15 <u>Corrections in establishing the pilot program.</u>
- 16 Section 10. The Unified Code of Corrections is amended
- 17 by adding Section 3-14-6 as follows:
- 18 (730 ILCS 5/3-14-6 new)
- 19 <u>Sec. 3-14-6. Transitional jobs; pilot program. The</u>
- 20 <u>Department shall establish a pilot program in 2 locations in</u>
- 21 <u>the State to place persons discharged from a Department</u>
- 22 <u>facility on parole or mandatory supervised release in jobs or</u>
- 23 <u>otherwise establish a connection between such persons and the</u>
- 24 workforce. By rule, the Department shall determine the
- 25 <u>locations in which the pilot program is to be implemented</u>
- 26 (one of which must be in the Lawndale community of Chicago)
- 27 <u>and the services to be provided. The Department may consult</u>
- 28 <u>with the Department of Human Services in establishing the</u>
