Subject 2 to appropriations or other funding, the Department may 3 4 establish a pilot program in 2 locations in the State to 5 place persons discharged from a Department facility on parole or mandatory supervised release in jobs or otherwise б 7 establish a connection between such persons and the workforce. By rule, the Department shall determine the 8 9 locations in which the pilot program is to be implemented and 10 the services to be provided. In determining locations for the pilot program, however, the Department shall give priority to 11 areas of the State in which the concentration of released 12 offenders is the highest. The Department may consult with the 13 Department of Human Services in establishing the pilot 14 15 program.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.".
