

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the
8 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Criminal

12 of local government, to include operational activities and
13 programs undertaken by the Authority, in support of Federal
14 Crime Bill Initiatives.

15 Section 8. The following amount, or so much thereof as
16 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Illinois Criminal
17 Justice Information Authority for awards and grants to state
18 agencies and units of local government, including operational
19 expenses of the Authority in support of the Juvenile
20 Accountability Incentive Block Grant program:
