SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

225 ILCS 15/7

from Ch. 111, par. 5357

Amends the Clinical Psychologist Licensing Act. Provides that the members of the Clinical Psychologists Licensing and Disciplinary Board appointed to fill a vacancy shall be eligible for reappointment to 2 full terms (rather only one full term). Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning professional regulation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Clinical Psychologist Licensing Act is 5 amended by changing Section 7 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 15/7) (from Ch. 111, par. 5357)

(Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2007)

8 Sec. 7. Board. The Director shall appoint a Board that 9 shall serve in an advisory capacity to the Director.

The Board shall consist of 7 persons, 4 of whom are 10 licensed clinical psychologists, and actively engaged in the 11 practice of clinical psychology, 2 of whom are licensed 12 clinical psychologists and are full time faculty members of 13 14 accredited colleges or universities who are engaged in training 15 clinical psychologists, and one of whom is a public member who is not a licensed health care provider. In appointing members 16 17 of the Board, the Director shall give due consideration to the adequate representation of the various fields of health care 18 19 psychology such as clinical psychology, school psychology and 20 counseling psychology. In appointing members of the Board, the 21 Director shall give due consideration to recommendations by 22 members of the profession of clinical psychology and by the State-wide 23 organizations representing the interests of clinical psychologists and organizations representing the 24 25 interests of academic programs as well as recommendations by 26 approved doctoral level psychology programs in the State of Illinois. The members shall be appointed for a term of 4 years. 27 28 No member shall be eligible to serve for more than 2 full 29 terms. Any appointment to fill a vacancy shall be for the 30 unexpired portion of the term. A member appointed to fill a vacancy shall be eligible for reappointment to 2 only one full 31 32 terms term. 1 time prior to the expiration of his or her term.

2 The Board shall annually elect one of its members as 3 chairperson and vice chairperson.

4 The members of the Board shall be reimbursed for all 5 authorized legitimate and necessary expenses incurred in 6 attending the meetings of the Board.

7 The Director shall give due consideration to all 8 recommendations of the Board. In the event the Director 9 disagrees with or takes action contrary to the recommendation 10 of the Board, he or she shall provide the Board with a written 11 and specific explanation of his or her actions.

12 A majority of the Board members currently appointed shall 13 constitute a quorum. A vacancy in the membership of the Board 14 shall not impair the right of a quorum to perform all of the 15 duties of the Board.

Members of the Board shall have no liability in any action based upon any disciplinary proceeding or other activity performed in good faith as a member of the Board.

19 The Director may terminate the appointment of any member 20 for cause which in the opinion of the Director reasonably 21 justifies such termination.
