

## 93RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2003 and 2004 HB4355

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-806.3

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-806.3

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that any military veteran who qualifies for the Senior Citizens Assessment Freeze Homestead Exemption under the Property Tax Code shall pay \$24, rather than the fee otherwise provided in the Vehicle Code, for registration of specified vehicles.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing Section 3-806.3 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-806.3) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-806.3)

Sec. 3-806.3. Senior Citizens.

Commencing with the 2001 registration year and extending through the 2003 registration year, the registration fee paid by any vehicle owner who has claimed and received a grant under the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act or who is the spouse of such a person shall be \$24 instead of the fee otherwise provided in this Code for passenger cars displaying standard multi-year registration plates issued under Section 3-414.1, motor vehicles displaying special registration plates issued under Section 3-616, motor vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(a) and recreational vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(b). Widows and widowers of claimants shall also be entitled to this reduced registration fee for the registration year in which the claimant was eligible.

Commencing with the 2004 registration year and extending through the 2005 registration year, the registration fee paid by any vehicle owner who has claimed and received a grant under the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act or who is the spouse of such a person shall be \$24 instead of the fee otherwise provided in this Code for passenger cars displaying standard multi-year registration plates issued under Section 3-414.1, motor vehicles displaying special registration plates issued under Section 3-616, 3-621, 3-622, 3-623, 3-624, 3-625, 3-626, 3-628,

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1 3-638, 3-642, 3-645, 3-647, 3-650, or 3-651, motor vehicles

2 registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(a), and

3 recreational vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under

Section 3-815(b). Widows and widowers of claimants shall also

be entitled to this reduced registration fee for the

registration year in which the claimant was eligible.

7 Commencing with the 2006 registration year, the 8 registration fee paid by any vehicle owner who has claimed and 9 received a grant under the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act or who is 10 11 the spouse of such a person or by any person who is a veteran, as defined in subsection (h) of Section 1491 of Title 10 of the 12 13 United States Code, who also qualifies for the Senior Citizens Assessment Freeze Homestead Exemption, as provided in Section 14 15 15-172 of the Property Tax Code, shall be \$24 instead of the 16 fee otherwise provided in this Code for passenger cars 17 displaying standard multi-year registration plates issued under Section 3-414.1, motor vehicles displaying special 18 registration plates issued under Section 3-616, 3-621, 3-622, 19 3-623, 3-624, 3-625, 3-626, 3-628, 3-638, 3-642, 3-645, 3-647, 20 3-650, or 3-651, motor vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or 21 less under Section 3-815(a), and recreational vehicles 22 23 registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(b). Widows and widowers of claimants shall also be entitled to this 24 reduced registration fee for the registration year in which the 25 claimant was eligible. 26

No more than one reduced registration fee under this Section shall be allowed during any 12 month period based on the primary eligibility of any individual, whether such reduced registration fee is allowed to the individual or to the spouse, widow or widower of such individual. This Section does not apply to the fee paid in addition to the registration fee for motor vehicles displaying vanity or special license plates.
