Appropriates various amounts from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for expenses. Effective July 1, 2004.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following amounts, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, are appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the Department of Human Services for FY05:

7 For the Family Assistance and Home Based Support
8 Services program\$10,000,000

9 For Centers for Independent Living for the
10 expansion of services\$1,000,000

11 For increasing community living options
12 for the developmentally disabled that include,
13 but are not limited to, the expansion of Community
14 Integrated Living Arrangements, Supported
15 Living, Shared Living Arrangements, and
16 Individual Family Options\$25,000,000

17 For a 4% Cost of Living increase for all
18 providers of the developmentally disabled
19 and the mentally ill.\$48,000,000

20 For the purposes of providing a rate increase
21 to Community Integrated Living Arrangements
22 for the developmentally disabled\$28,000,000

23 For the purposes of providing a rate increase
24 for transportation services for the
25 developmentally disabled\$13,600,000

26 For Community Integrated Living Arrangements
27 for the mentally ill and supportive housing
28 initiatives for the mentally ill\$11,700,000

29 For the expansion of respite services\$10,000,000

30 For Integrated Employment and Self-employment
31 Initiatives for the developmentally disabled
32 and the mentally ill\$10,000,000

1	For developmental disability providers to assist	
2	them in the conversion of a grant system to a	
3	purchase of care system	\$18,000,000
4	For the purpose of providing leadership training	
5	for developmental disability providers on	
6	system change	<u>\$3,000,000</u>
7	Total	\$178,300,000

8 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July
9 1, 2004.
