7 vehicles displaying special registration plates issued under
8 Section 3-616, 3-621, 3-622, 3-623, 3-624, 3-625, 3-626, 3-628,
9 3-638, 3-642, 3-645, 3-647, 3-650, or 3-651, motor vehicles
10 registered at 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(a), and
11 recreational vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under
12 Section 3-815(b). Widows and widowers of claimants shall also
13 be entitled to this reduced registration fee for the
14 registration year in which the claimant was eligible.

15 Commencing with the 2006 registration year, the
16 registration fee paid by any vehicle owner who has claimed and
17 received a grant under the Senior Citizens and Disabled Persons
18 Property Tax Relief and Pharmaceutical Assistance Act or who is
19 the spouse of such a person shall be \$24 instead of the fee
20 otherwise provided in this Code for passenger cars displaying
21 standard multi-year registration plates issued under Section
22 3-414.1, motor vehicles displaying special registration plates
23 issued under Section 3-607, 3-616, 3-621, 3-622, 3-623, 3-624,
24 3-625, 3-626, 3-628, 3-638, 3-642, 3-645, 3-647, 3-650, or
25 3-651, motor vehicles registered at 8,000 pounds or less under
26 Section 3-815(a), and recreational vehicles registered at
27 8,000 pounds or less under Section 3-815(b). Widows and
28 widowers of claimants shall also be entitled to this reduced
29 registration fee for the registration year in which the
30 claimant was eligible.

31 No more than one reduced registration fee under this
32 Section shall be allowed during any 12 month period based on
33 the primary eligibility of any individual, whether such reduced
34 registration fee is allowed to the individual or to the spouse,

1 widow or widower of such individual. This Section does not
2 apply to the fee paid in addition to the registration fee for
3 motor vehicles displaying vanity or special license plates.
