SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/12-5.15 new

Amends the Criminal Code of 1961. Creates the offense of aggravated criminal housing management. Defines the offense as committing criminal housing management and (1) the condition endangering the health or safety of a person is determined to be the a contributing factor in the death of that person and (2) the person also conceals or attempts to conceal the condition that endangered the health or safety of the person that is found to be a contributing factor in that death. Provides that the penalty is a Class 4 felony.

3 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
4 **represented in the General Assembly:**

5 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by adding
6 Section 12-5.15 as follows:

7 (720 ILCS 5/12-5.15 new)

8 Sec. 12-5.15. Aggravated criminal housing management.

9 (a) A person commits the offense of aggravated criminal
10 housing management when he or she commits the offense of
11 criminal housing management; and:

12 (1) the condition endangering the health or safety of a
13 person is determined to be a contributing factor in the
14 death of that person; and

15 (2) the person also conceals or attempts to conceal the
16 condition that endangered the health or safety of the
17 person that is found to be a contributing factor in that
18 death.

19 (b) Sentence. Aggravated criminal housing management is a
20 Class 4 felony.
