Amends the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963. Makes a technical change in a Section that permits the defendant to waive his or her right to be present during trial.

1 AN ACT in relation to criminal procedure.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is
5 amended by changing Section 115-8 as follows:

6 (725 ILCS 5/115-8) (from Ch. 38, par. 115-8)

7 Sec. 115-8. A defendant may waive his or her right to be
8 present during trial. However, upon motion of the State's
9 Attorney made prior to or during trial, the court shall order
10 the defendant to present himself in open court for the purpose
11 of identification.
