3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Optometric Practice Act of 1987 is
5 amended by changing Section 4 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 80/4) (from Ch. 111, par. 3904)

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2007)

8 Sec. 4. Necessity of license. No person shall practice~~r~~ or
9 attempt to practice~~r~~ optometry, as defined in this Act, without
10 a valid license as an optometrist issued by the Department.
