AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 6394 1 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 6394 by replacing 3 everything after the enacting clause with the following: "Section 5. The Illinois Police Training Act is amended by 4 5 adding Section 10.7 as follows: (50 ILCS 705/10.7 new) 6 7 Sec. 10.7. Mandatory training; police chief and deputy police chief. (a) Each police chief and deputy police chief shall obtain 9 at least 20 hours of training each year. The training must be 10 approved by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards 11 Board and must be related to law enforcement, management or 12 executive development, or ethics. This requirement may be 13 satisfied by attending the Illinois Association of Chiefs of 14 Police conference. Any police chief and any deputy police 15 16 chief, upon presentation of a certificate of completion from the person or entity conducting the training, shall be 17 reimbursed by the municipality for his or her reasonable 18 expenses in obtaining the training required under this Section. 19 (b) Units of local government, including home rule units, 20 may not regulate the training of police chiefs and deputy 21 police chiefs in a manner inconsistent with this Section. This 22 Section is a limitation under subsection (i) of Section 6 of 23

Article VII of the Illinois Constitution on the concurrent

- 3 Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding
- 4 Section 8.28 as follows:
- (30 ILCS 805/8.28 new) 5
- 6 Sec. 8.28. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8
- of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the 7
- implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of 8
- 9 the 93rd General Assembly.".
