SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 105/5.625 new 775 ILCS 5/7-112.5 new

Amends the Illinois Human Rights Act. Authorizes the Department of Human Rights to charge fees to private companies for training offered by the Department's Institute for Training and Development. Provides that the fees shall be paid into the Department of Human Rights Training and Development Fund, a new special fund in the State treasury (and amends the State Finance Act to list the new fund as a special fund). Provides that moneys in the Fund shall be used to enhance the quality of the Department's training services, make training available at no cost to agency employees, other State agencies and instrumentalities of the State, community organizations, colleges and universities, and other groups and organizations in Illinois, and make training available to private companies for a fee. Effective January 1, 2005.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 12 <u>Sec. 7-112.5. Training fee. The Department is authorized to</u>
- charge fees to private companies for training offered by the
- 14 <u>Department's Institute for Training and Development. The fees</u>
- shall be paid into the Department of Human Rights Training and
- Development Fund, a special fund that is created in the State
- 17 <u>treasury. Moneys in the Fund shall be used to: (i) enhance the</u>
- 18 quality of the Department's training services; (ii) make
- 19 <u>training available at no cost to agency employees, other State</u>
- 20 agencies and instrumentalities of the State, community
- 21 <u>organizations</u>, colleges and universities, and other groups and
- 22 <u>organizations in Illinois; and (iii) make training available to</u>
- 23 private companies for a fee.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January
- 25 1, 2005.
