A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
7 for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the
8 State Fire Marshal, as follows:

28 Section 2. The sum of \$375,000, or so much thereof as
29 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
30 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for

1 administrative expenses of the Elevator Safety and Regulation
2 Act.

3 Section 3. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may
4 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Firefighters'
5 Memorial Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for
6 expenses related to the maintenance of the Illinois
7 Firefighters' Memorial, holding the annual Fallen Firefighter
8 Ceremony, and other expenses as allowed under Public Act 91-
9 0832.

10 Section 4. The following named amounts, or so much
11 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
12 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal as follows:

13 Payable from the Fire Prevention Fund:

14	For Fire Prevention Training	45,000
15	For Expenses of Fire Prevention	
16	Awareness Program	75,000
17	For Expenses of Arson Education

26 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
27 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
28 for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the
29 State Fire Marshal, as follows:

9 Section 6. The sum of \$2,000, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund
11 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available
12 for the development of new fire districts.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July 1,
14 2004.
