23 Section 2. The sum of \$375,000, or so much thereof as
24 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
25 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for
26 administrative expenses of the Elevator Safety and Regulation
27 Act.

28 Section 3. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may
29 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Firefighters'
30 Memorial Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for
31 expenses related to the maintenance of the Illinois

1 Firefighters' Memorial, holding the annual Fallen Firefighter
2 Ceremony, and other expenses as allowed under Public Act 91-
3 0832.

4 Section 4. The following named amounts, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
6 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal as follows:

7 Payable from the Fire Prevention Fund:

- 8 For Fire Prevention Training\$45,000
- 9 For Expenses of Fire Prevention
- 10 Awareness Program75,000
- 11 For Expenses of Arson Education
- 12 and Seminars23,500

16 Payable from the Fire Prevention Division Fund:

24 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
25 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated
26 for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the
27 State Fire Marshal, as follows:

7 Section 6. The sum of \$2,000, or so much thereof as may
8 be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund
9 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available
10 for the development of new fire districts.

11 Section 7. The sum of \$550,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground
13 Storage Tank Fund to the Environmental Protection Agency for
14 a grant to the City of Chicago for Administrative Costs
15 incurred as a result of the State's Underground Storage
16 Program.

17 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July 1,
18 2004."
