A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects  
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the  
8 General Revenue Fund to meet the ordinary and contingent  
9 expenses of the Office of the Lieutenant Governor:

30 Section 10. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as  
31 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Agricultural

1 Premium Fund to the Office of Lieutenant Governor for all  
2 costs associated with the Rural Affairs Council including any  
3 grants or administration expenses.

4 Section 15. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as  
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Lieutenant  
6 Governor's Grant Fund to the Office of Lieutenant Governor to  
7 be expended in accordance with the terms and conditions upon  
8 which such funds were received and in the exercise of the  
9 powers or performance of the duties of the Office of the  
10 Lieutenant Governor.

11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July 1,  
12 2004.
