5 WHEREAS, Maria "Tonne" Ulmer-Glover was born on April 1, 6 1949, in Chicago, to the union of David and Mary Atkins; she 7 accepted Christ at an early age and remained steadfast in her 8 faith throughout her life; and

WHEREAS, She graduated from Harlan High School and attended the University of Illinois at Champaign; she matriculated from Roosevelt University receiving a degree in accounting; and

WHEREAS, In 1981, she began her service to the citizens of the State of Illinois by joining the staff of the then newly created Illinois Department of Human Rights (IDHR); she served in the capacity of Chief Accountant; and

WHEREAS, Maria performed in an outstanding manner throughout her tenure with the Illinois Department of Human Rights, working tirelessly and unselfishly to develop and maintain the fiscal integrity of the IDHR; through the years, she distinguished herself in many facets of her work, one of which was becoming the first African-American female in the State to be promoted to the lofty position of Chief Fiscal Officer for a Cabinet-level agency; and

WHEREAS, She worked closely and effectively with the members of the Illinois General Assembly in many areas, but particularly in its effort to ensure the fiscal integrity of the State's budget; she developed and piloted the budget of the Illinois Department of Human Rights through the legislative process with efficiency, professionalism, and competence; she earned the respect and admiration of many members of the
