- 2 WHEREAS, Colorectal cancer is the second leading cause of
- 3 cancer deaths in men and women combined in the United States;
- 4 and
- 5 WHEREAS, It is estimated that in the year 2004, nearly
- 6 147,000 new cases of colorectal cancer will be diagnosed in the
- 7 United States; and
- 8 WHEREAS, In the year 2004, the disease is expected to kill
- 9 over 56,700 individuals in this country; and
- 10 WHEREAS, An estimated 6,680 individuals in the State of
- 11 Illinois will be diagnosed with colorectal cancer in the year
- 12 2004; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Screening for colorectal cancer is underutilized,
- 14 regular screenings can detect polyps that lead to colorectal
- 15 cancer and can save lives; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Adopting a healthy diet at a young age can
- 17 significantly reduce the risk of developing colorectal cancer;
- 18 and
- 19 WHEREAS, March is also designated as National Nutrition
- 20 Awareness Month; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Education can help inform the public of methods of
- 22 prevention and symptoms of early detection; and
- 23 WHEREAS, The State of Illinois should help inform the
- 24 public about colorectal cancer prevention and screening;
- 25 therefore be it

- 2 hereby proclaim the month of March as Colorectal Cancer
