2 WHEREAS, The members of the House of Representatives of the

4 Firefighter/Paramedic Brian Baldwin of Brookfield on being  
5 named 2003 Firefighter/Paramedic of the Year by the

18 Firefighter/Paramedic Baldwin resulted in a favorable outcome

21 station that greatly benefit everyone; his outstanding skills  
22 and dedication led to him receiving this award; therefore, be
