2 WHEREAS, The need for highly qualified paraprofessionals

3 and teachers in early childhood education is growing; and

WHEREAS, The articulation of early childhood education courses at the community college level with program requirements at baccalaureate-granting institutions needs to

7 be strengthened; and

WHEREAS, The Illinois P-16 Education Initiative has been developing the Associate of Arts in Teaching (AAT) degree models as a mechanism to better coordinate community college programs with university teacher education programs; therefore

13 RESOLVED, ΒY THEHOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES NINETY-THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that 14 15 Illinois P-16 Education Initiative, working 16 representatives from the Illinois Community College Board (ICCB), the Illinois Board of Higher Education (IBHE), the 17 Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE), community colleges, 18 19 and public and private universities, shall develop a model Associate of Arts in Teaching degree in early childhood 20 education; and be it further 21

RESOLVED, That the model AAT in early childhood education shall be presented for consideration to the ICCB and IBHE no later than June 30, 2005; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Boards, after approval of the model AAT degree in early childhood education, will work with all interested parties to approve individual community college programs no later than June 30, 2006; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Board of Higher Education shall report

- 1 $\,$ to the Illinois House of Representatives and the Office of the
- 2 Governor on the status of acceptance of the AAT by each public
- 3 university within six months of the IBHE approval of the model
- 4 AAT degree in early childhood education; and be it further
- 5 RESOLVED, That the Board of Higher Education shall report
- on the progress of this initiative to the House Higher
- 7 Education Committee no later than February 15, 2005; and be it
- 8 further
- 9 RESOLVED, That community college students transferring to
- 10 a senior institution with the AAT in early childhood education
- 11 shall have equal status with university native students at the
- beginning of their junior year, and will be in a position to
- 13 graduate with a baccalaureate degree in early childhood
- 14 education in an amount of time that is similar to that of
- 15 native students; and be it further
- 16 RESOLVED, That community colleges should be strongly
- 17 encouraged to continue Associate in Applied Science (AAS)
- 18 programs in early childhood education, in addition to
- developing the AAT; if feasible, the core curriculum for the
- 20 AAT programs should be used in the AAS programs to maximize the
- 21 credits that would be transferable in the event an AAS
- recipient changes career paths; and be it further
- 23 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
- 24 provided to the Office of the Governor, the Chairman of the
- 25 Board of Higher Education, the Chairman of the Illinois
- 26 Community College Board, the Chairman of the Illinois State
- 27 Board of Education, and the Illinois P-16 Education Initiative.
