Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The State Aid Continuing Appropriation Law is 5 amended by changing Sections 15-10, 15-15, and 15-25 and 6 adding Section 15-21 as follows:

If the General б 7 Assembly fails to make Common School Fund appropriations to 8 the State Board of Education in fiscal year 2004 or in any fiscal year thereafter sufficient to fund (i) the General 9 10 State Aid Formula set forth in subsection (E) (Computation of General State Aid) and subsection (H) (Supplemental General 11 State Aid) of Section 18-8.05 of the School Code and (ii) the 12 13 supplementary payments for school districts set forth in subsection (J) (Supplementary Grants in Aid) of Section 14 18-8.05 of the School Code, this Law shall constitute an 15 irrevocable and continuing appropriation from the Common 16 School Fund of all amounts necessary for those purposes. 17
