

1 AN ACT concerning livestock.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,  
3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Livestock Dealer Licensing Act  
5 is amended by changing Section 17 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 645/17) (from Ch. 111, par. 417)

7 Sec. 17. Records. Each licensee shall maintain records of  
8 each purchase under this Act including identification of  
9 livestock purchased, the name and address of the seller, and  
10 the date of purchase, and a record of each sale, including  
11 date, buyer, number, and identification of animals. All  
12 reports of sales of female feeder cattle must be mailed to  
13 the Department weekly on forms furnished by the Department.

14 These records along with any accompanying health  
15 certificates shall be maintained for a period of 3 years.
