Upon receipt of this certification, the Treasurer shall transfer from the General Revenue Fund to a special fund in the State treasury, known as the School District Distributive Fund, the amount shown on the certification.

All amounts paid into the Local Government Distributive Fund and the School District Distributive Fund in accordance with this Section and allocated pursuant to this Act are appropriated on a continuing basis.
