- 1 AN ACT in relation to education.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
- 5 2-3.250 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/2-3.25o new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 2-3.25o. Registration and recognition of non-public</u>
- 8 <u>elementary and secondary schools.</u>
- 9 (a) Findings. The General Assembly finds and declares
- 10 (i) that the Constitution of the State of Illinois provides
- 11 that a "fundamental goal of the People of the State is the
- 12 <u>educational development of all persons to the limits of their</u>
- 13 <u>capacities" and (ii) that the educational development of</u>
- 14 <u>every school student serves the public purposes of the State.</u>
- 15 <u>In order to ensure that all Illinois students and teachers</u>
- 16 <u>have the opportunity to enroll and work in State-approved</u>
- 17 <u>educational institutions and programs, the State Board of</u>
- 18 Education shall provide for the voluntary registration and
- 19 <u>recognition of non-public elementary and secondary schools.</u>
- 20 (b) Registration. All non-public elementary and
- 21 <u>secondary schools in the State of Illinois may voluntarily</u>
- 22 <u>register with the State Board of Education on an annual</u>
- 23 <u>basis. Registration shall be completed in conformance with</u>
- 24 procedures prescribed by the State Board of Education.
- 25 <u>Information required for registration shall include</u>
- 26 <u>assurances of compliance (i) with federal and State laws</u>
- 27 <u>regarding health examination and immunization, attendance,</u>
- 28 <u>length</u> of term, and nondiscrimination and (ii) with
- 29 <u>applicable fire and health safety requirements.</u>
- 30 (c) Recognition. All non-public elementary and
- 31 <u>secondary schools in the State of Illinois may voluntarily</u>

- 1 seek the status of "Non-public School Recognition" from the
- State Board of Education. This status may be obtained by 2
- compliance with administrative quidelines and review 3
- 4 procedures as prescribed by the State Board of Education. The
- 5 guidelines and procedures must recognize that some of the
- aims and the financial bases of non-public schools are б
- 7 different from public schools and will not be identical to
- those for public schools, nor will they be more burdensome. 8
- 9 The guidelines and procedures must also recognize the
- diversity of non-public schools and shall not impinge upon 10
- the noneducational relationships between those schools and 11
- their clientele. 12
- (d) Public purposes. The provisions of this Section are 13
- in the public interest, for the public benefit, and serve 14
- 15 secular public purposes.
- (e) Definition. For purposes of this Section, a 16
- 17 non-public school means any non-profit, non-home-based, and
- non-public elementary or secondary school that is in 18
- compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and 19
- attendance at which satisfies the requirements of Section 20
- 26-1 of this Code. 21
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 22
- becoming law. 23
