

1 AN ACT in relation to highways.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Highway Code is amended by
5 changing Section 6-315 as follows:

6 (605 ILCS 5/6-315) (from Ch. 121, par. 6-315)

7 Sec. 6-315. An entry in the records, ledger, or official
8 minute book of the district clerk, stating that there has
9 been a dedication of a public highway according to statutory
10 requirements or a certified copy of such record--and--papers,
11 relating--to--laying-out,-alteration,-widening-or-vacation-of
12 any-township-or-district-road shall be prima facie evidence
13 in all cases that there was a dedication of a public highway
14 and that the dedication complied with all statutory
15 requirements, regardless of whether supporting records or
16 documentation of the dedication is available all---the
17 necessary--antecedent-provisions-have-been-complied-with,-and
18 that-the-action-of-the-highway-commissioner-or-other--persons
19 and-officers,-in-regard-thereto,-was-regular-in-all-respects.
