- 8 (a) Notwithstanding any provision in the declaration,

- 11 <u>association or a common interest community association or a</u>

- 13 (a) Notwithstanding any provision in the association's
- 14 <u>declaration</u>, covenants, bylaws, rules, regulations, or other

- 16 by an association's board of directors, a homeowners'
- 17 <u>association incorporated under this Act may not prohibit the</u>
- 18 <u>outdoor display of the American flag by a homeowner on that</u>
