- 1 AN ACT concerning budget stabilization.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 5 State Budget Containment Act.
- 6 Section 5. State fiscal year appropriations cap. The
- 7 aggregate appropriations from the general funds made by the
- 8 General Assembly for any given State fiscal year, including
- 9 supplemental appropriations, shall be no more than 104% of
- 10 the aggregate appropriations from the general funds for the
- 11 immediately prior State fiscal year, including supplemental
- 12 appropriations.
- 13 Section 10. Excess revenue transferred to Budget
- 14 Stabilization Fund.
- 15 (a) On August 1 each year, or as soon thereafter as
- 16 practical, the Bureau of the Budget shall certify the amount
- of all general funds revenues received by the State during
- 18 the immediately prior State fiscal year. If the general funds
- 19 revenues received by the State during the immediately prior

State fiscal year exceed the general funds revenues received

by the State during the State fiscal year immediately prior

- 22 to the immediately prior State fiscal year by more than 4%,
- 23 then any excess over that 4% shall be transferred into the
- 24 Budget Stabilization Fund.
- 25 (b) The General Assembly, by the vote of no less than
- three-fifths of the members elected to each house, may pass a
- 27 bill to stop or reverse the automatic transfer required by
- 28 subsection (a).
