- 8 Sec. 50-6. State budget for performance-based budgeting
- 9 pilot program agencies. The Governor's recommended budget for
- 10 the State fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004 shall be a
- 11 performance-based budget for agencies participating in the
- 12 <u>performance-based budgeting pilot program pursuant to Section</u>
- 13 <u>10 of the Bureau of the Budget Act.</u>
- 14 Section 10. The Bureau of the Budget Act is amended by
- 15 adding Section 10 as follows:
- 16 (20 ILCS 3005/10 new)
- 17 <u>Sec. 10. Performance-based budgeting pilot program.</u>
- 18 <u>(a) "Performance-based budgeting" means a method of</u>
- 19 <u>budgeting</u> in which the allocation of program moneys is tied
- 20 <u>to measures that indicate how well the program is meeting the</u>
- 21 goals established for the program.
- (b) During the State fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004,
- 23 <u>the Bureau of the Budget, in consultation with the applicable</u>
- 24 <u>House and Senate appropriation committees, shall develop</u>

- 5 (e) The Bureau shall report on the progress and success
- of the pilot program to the 94th and 95th General Assemblies. 6
- 7 The report shall include, but not be limited to, the progress
- and success of the pilot program and the Bureau's 8
- recommendations for changes to or extensions of the pilot 9
- 10 program.
- 11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
