- 19 <u>information relating to the history of the Illinois National</u>
- 20 Guard.
- 21 (b) The Commission consists of 15 members: the Adjutant

- 1 General, the State Historian, the Director of the Illinois 2 State Museum, and the Director of the Historic Preservation Agency, all ex officio; 4 members of the General Assembly, 3 4 one of whom shall be appointed by the President of the Senate, one by the Minority Leader of the Senate, one by the 5 6 Speaker of the House of Representatives, and one by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives; and 7 7 residents of the State appointed by the Governor. When 8 9 appointing members to the Commission, the Governor must endeavor to appoint persons in a manner to maintain as 10 regionally diverse a membership as possible. Persons 11 appointed to the Commission should provide it with experience 12 in areas such as, but not limited to, knowledge of military 13 history, particularly of the American Civil War, and the 14 education of citizens. Any vacancy in the Commission shall 15 be filled by an appointment in the same manner as the 16 original appointment. Members of the Commission shall serve 17 without compensation, but shall be reimbursed for their 18 19 reasonable expenses incurred in the performance of their 20 duties.
- 21 (c) This Section is repealed on January 1, 2006.
- 22 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 23 becoming law.".
