

## 93RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2003 and 2004 SB2195

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

765 ILCS 1025/9

from Ch. 141, par. 109

Amends the Uniform Disposition of Unclaimed Property Act. Exempts funds held in a lawyer's trust account established under Supreme Court Rules from being presumed abandoned after the funds have remained unclaimed for 5 years. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Uniform Disposition of Unclaimed Property
- 5 Act is amended by changing Section 9 as follows:
- 6 (765 ILCS 1025/9) (from Ch. 141, par. 109)
- Sec. 9. All personal property, not otherwise covered by 7 this Act, including any income or increment thereon that the 8 owner would be entitled to and deducting any lawful charges, 9 10 that has remained unclaimed by the owner for more than 5 years is presumed abandoned. Before reporting and delivering 11 property as required under this Act, a business association may 12 deduct from the amount of otherwise reportable intangible 13 14 personal property the economic loss suffered by it in 15 connection with that intangible personal property arising from transactions involving the sale of tangible personal property 16 17 at retail. Except as provided in Section 10.5, this provision 18 shall not apply to personal property held prior to October 1, 19 1968 by business associations. Property remitted to the State 20 pursuant to this Act, prior to the effective date of this amendatory Act of 1982, shall not be affected by this 21 22 amendatory Act of 1982.
- 23 <u>This Act shall not apply to abandoned funds held in a</u>
  24 <u>lawyer's trust account established under Supreme Court Rules.</u>

- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
