Amends the Public Utilities Act. Abolishes the Illinois Commerce Commission Police Force and transfers its officers and records to the Department of State Police. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT in relation to public utilities.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Public Utilities Act is amended by adding  
5 Section 2-103.5 as follows:

6 (220 ILCS 5/2-103.5 new)

7 Sec. 2-103.5. Illinois Commerce Commission Police Force  
8 eliminated. On the effective date of this amendatory Act of the  
9 93rd General Assembly, the Illinois Commerce Commission Police  
10 Force is abolished. On the effective date of this amendatory  
11 Act of the 93rd General Assembly, all Illinois Commerce  
12 Commission Police Officers are transferred to the jurisdiction  
13 of the Department of State Police and all books, records, and  
14 accounts relating to the Illinois Commerce Commission Police  
15 Force are transferred to the Department of State Police.

16 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
17 becoming law.
