1 AN ACT concerning civil procedure.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by
5 changing Section 2-1702 as follows:

6 (735 ILCS 5/2-1702) (from Ch. 110, par. 2-1702)

7 (Text of Section WITHOUT the changes made by P.A. 89-7,
8 which has been held unconstitutional)

9 Sec. 2-1702. Economic loss; non-economic loss.

10 ~~Economic/Non-Economic Loss.~~ As used in this Part:

11 (a) "Economic loss" means all pecuniary harm for which
12 damages are recoverable.

13 (b) "Non-economic loss" means loss of consortium and all
14 nonpecuniary harm for which damages are recoverable,
15 including, without limitation, damages for pain and suffering,
16 inconvenience, disfigurement, and physical impairment.
