

1 AN ACT concerning schools.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
5 9-12 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/9-12) (from Ch. 122, par. 9-12)

7 Sec. 9-12. Ballots for the election of school officers
8 shall be in one of the following forms:

13 This format is used by Boards of School Directors. School
14 Directors are elected at large.)

2 This format is used when school board members are elected
3 at large. Membership on the school board is not restricted by
4 area of residence.

5 Types of school districts generally using this format are:

6 Common school districts;

7 Community unit and community consolidated school districts
8 formed on or after January 1, 1975;

9 Community unit school districts formed prior to January 1,
10 1975 that elect board members at large and without restriction
11 by area of residence within the district under subsection (c)
12 of Section 11A-8;

13 Community unit, community consolidated and combined school
14 districts in which more than 90% of the population is in one
15 congressional township;

16 High school districts in which less than 15% of the taxable
17 property is located in unincorporated territory; and unit
18 districts (OLD TYPE);

19 Combined school districts formed on or after July 1, 1983;

20 Combined school districts formed before July 1, 1983 and
21 community consolidated school districts that elect board
22 members at large and without restriction by area of residence
23 within the district under subsection (c) of Section 11B-7.)

13 used only in electing, when required under Section 10-10, a

 20 shall be determined by the order of petition filing or lottery
 21 held pursuant to Sections 9-11.1 and 9-11.2.

22 This format is used by community unit, community
 23 consolidated and combined school districts when the territory
 24 is less than 2 congressional townships, or 72 square miles, but
 25 consists of more than one congressional township, or 36 square
 26 miles, outside of the corporate limits of any city, village or
 27 incorporated town within the school district. The School Code
 28 requires that not more than 5 board members shall be selected
 29 from any city, village or incorporated town in the school
 30 district. At least two board members must reside in the
 31 unincorporated area of the school district.

32 Except for those community unit school districts formed
 33 before January 1, 1975 that elect board members at large and
 34 without restriction by area of residence within the district

1 under subsection (c) of Section 11A-8 and except for combined
 2 school districts formed before July 1, 1983 and community
 3 consolidated school districts that elect board members at large
 4 and without restriction by area of residence within the
 5 district under subsection (c) of Section 11B-7, this format
 6 applies to community unit and community consolidated school
 7 districts formed prior to January 1, 1975 and combined school
 8 districts formed prior to July 1, 1983.)

9 OFFICIAL BALLOT

10 Instructions to voter: The board of education shall be
 11 composed of members from both the incorporated and the
 12 unincorporated area; not more than 5 board members shall be

6 the order of petition filing or lottery held pursuant to
7 Sections 9-11.1 and 9-11.2.

8 Except for those community unit school districts formed
 9 prior to January 1, 1975 that elect board members at large and
 10 without restriction by area of residence within the district
 11 under subsection (c) of Section 11A-8 and except for those
 12 combined school districts formed before July 1, 1983 and
 13 community consolidated school districts that elect board
 14 members at large and without restriction by area of residence
 15 within the district under subsection (c) of Section 11B-7, this
 16 format applies to community unit and community consolidated
 17 school districts formed prior to January 1, 1975 and combined
 18 school districts formed prior to July 1, 1983 when the
 19 territory of the school district is greater than 2
 20 congressional townships, or 72 square miles. This format
 21 applies only when less than 75% of the population is in one
 22 congressional township. Congressional townships of less than
 23 100 inhabitants shall not be considered for the purpose of such
 24 mandatory board representation. In this case, not more than 3
 25 board members may be selected from any one congressional
 26 township.)

 2 under subsection (c) of Section 11A-8 and except for those
 3 combined school districts formed before July 1, 1983 and
 4 community consolidated school districts that elect board
 5 members at large and without restriction by area of residence
 6 within the district under subsection (c) of Section 11B-7, this
 7 format is used by community unit and community consolidated
 8 school districts formed prior to January 1, 1975, and combined
 9 school districts formed prior to July 1, 1983, when the
 10 territory of the school district is greater than 2
 11 congressional townships, or 72 square miles and when at least
 12 75%, but not more than 90%, of the population resides in one
 13 congressional township. In this case, 4 school board members
 14 shall be selected from that one congressional township and the
 15 3 remaining board members shall be selected from the rest of
 16 the district. If a school district from which school board
 17 members are to be selected is located in a county under
 18 township organization and if the surveyed boundaries of a
 19 congressional township from which one or more of those school
 20 board members is to be selected, as described by township
 21 number and range, are coterminous with the boundaries of the
 22 township as identified by the township name assigned to it as a
 23 political subdivision of the State, then that township may be
 24 referred to on the ballot by both its township name and by
 25 township number and range.)
