- 12 Sec. 8h. Transfers to General Revenue Fund.
- (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), notwithstanding 13 14 Notwithstanding any other State law to the contrary, the Director of the Governor's Office of Management and Budget may 15 from time to time direct the State Treasurer and Comptroller to 16 17 transfer a specified sum from any fund held by the State 18 Treasurer to the General Revenue Fund in order to help defray 19 the State's operating costs for the fiscal year. The total transfer under this Section from any fund in any fiscal year 20 shall not exceed the lesser of 8% of the revenues to be 21 22 deposited into the fund during that year or 25% of the 23 beginning balance in the fund. No transfer may be made from a 24 fund under this Section that would have the effect of reducing the available balance in the fund to an amount less than the 25
- 26 amount remaining unexpended and unreserved from the total
- 27 appropriation from that fund for that fiscal year. This Section
- does not apply to any funds that are restricted by federal law
- to a specific use or to any funds in the Motor Fuel Tax Fund or
- 30 the Hospital Provider Fund. Notwithstanding any other
- 31 provision of this Section, the total transfer under this
- 32 Section from the Road Fund or the State Construction Account

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Fund shall not exceed 5% of the revenues to be deposited into 1 2 the fund during that year.

In determining the available balance in a fund, the Director of the Governor's Office of Management and Budget may include receipts, transfers into the fund, and other resources anticipated to be available in the fund in that fiscal year.

The State Treasurer and Comptroller shall transfer the amounts designated under this Section as soon as may be practicable after receiving the direction to transfer from the Director of the Governor's Office of Management and Budget.

(b) This Section does not apply to the Nursing Home 11 Conversion Fund, the Nursing Home Transition Planning Grant 12 Fund, or the Alternative Long-Term Care Services for Older 13 Adults Fund. 14
