Makes appropriations to the University of Illinois for its FY05 ordinary and contingent expenses. Effective July 1, 2004.

**A BILL FOR**

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The following named sums, or so much thereof  
5 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and  
6 purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the General  
7 Revenue Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of  
8 Illinois to meet the ordinary and contingent expenses of the  
9 University of Illinois, including payment to the University  
10 for personal services and related costs incurred during the  
11 fiscal year:

12 For Personal Services .....\$611,035,700

13 Included in the above amount is a sum for salaries accrued  
14 but unpaid to academic personnel for personal services  
15 rendered during the academic year 2003-2004.

16 For State Contributions to Social  
17 Security/Medicare .....8,937,100  
18 For Contractual Services .....52,045,100  
19 For Travel .....249,700  
20 For Commodities .....2,518,600  
21 For Equipment .....511,000  
22 For Telecommunications .....5,016,800  
23 For Operation of Automotive Equipment .....967,000  
24 For Permanent Improvements .....750,000

25 For distributive purposes as follows:  
26 For Claims under Workers' Compensation and  
27 Occupational Diseases Acts, other statutes,  
28 and tort claims .....3,270,000  
29 For Awards and Grants .....5,782,500

4 Section 15. The sum of \$1,744,600, or so much thereof as  
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention  
6 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois  
7 for the purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service  
8 Institute and paying the expenses and providing the  
9 facilities and structures incident thereto, including payment  
10 to the University for personal services and related costs.

11 Section 20. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as  
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and  
13 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of the  
14 University of Illinois for scholarship grant awards, in  
15 accordance with Public Act 91-83.

16 Section 30. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as  
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Tobacco Settlement  
18 Recovery Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of  
19 Illinois for the ordinary and contingent expenses for  
20 technology transfer.

21 Section 35. The sum of \$52,953, or so much thereof as  
22 may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004,  
23 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in  
24 Article 4, Section 30 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated  
25 from the Capital Development Fund to the Board of Trustees of  
26 the University of Illinois to plan for all aspects of  
27 construction and to acquire and develop land, including  
28 demolition, landscaping, site improvements, extension and  
29 modification of campus utility systems, relocation of  
30 programs, and such other expenses as may be necessary to

1 construct a College of Medicine building in Chicago.

2 Section 40. The sum of \$18,638,542, or so much thereof  
3 as may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004,  
4 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in  
5 Article 4, Section 35 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated  
6 from the Capital Development Fund to the Board of Trustees of  
7 the University of Illinois to construct an education and  
8 research facility for the College of Medicine in Chicago,  
9 including planning, land acquisition, demolition,  
10 construction, remodeling, landscaping, site improvements,  
11 equipment, extension or modification of campus utility  
12 systems, relocation of programs, and such expenses as may be  
13 necessary to complete the facility.

14 Section 45. The sum of \$44,997, or so much thereof as  
15 may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004,  
16 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in  
17 Article 4, Section 45 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated  
18 from the Capital Development Fund to the University of  
19 Illinois for planning, construction, and equipment for a  
20 computer science in engineering facility.

21 Section 50. The sum of \$12,291,197, or so much thereof  
22 as may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004,  
23 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in  
24 Article 4, Section 50 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated  
25 from the Capital Development Fund to the University of  
26 Illinois at Springfield for constructing a classroom and  
27 office building, in addition to funds previously  
28 appropriated.

29 Section 55. The sum of \$814,444, or so much thereof as  
30 may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004,

1 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in  
2 Article 4, Section 55 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated  
3 from the Capital Development Fund to the University of  
4 Illinois for digitalization infrastructure for WILL-TV  
5 (Urbana-Champaign).

6 Section 60. The sum of \$446,170, or so much thereof as  
7 may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004,  
8 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in  
9 Article 4, Section 60 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated  
10 from the Capital Development Fund to the University of  
11 Illinois for digitalization infrastructure for WILL-TV  
12 (Urbana-Champaign).

13 Section 65. The sum of \$814,444, or so much thereof as  
14 may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004,  
15 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in  
16 Article 4, Section 65 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated  
17 from the Capital Development Fund to the University of  
18 Illinois for digitalization infrastructure for WILL-TV  
19 (Urbana-Champaign).

20 Section 70. The sum of \$13,916,332, or so much thereof  
21 as may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004,  
22 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in  
23 Article 4, Section 70 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated  
24 from the Capital Development Fund to the Board of Trustees of  
25 the University of Illinois to plan and construct an Education  
26 and Research facility for the College of Medicine in Chicago,  
27 including planning, land acquisition, demolition,  
28 construction, remodeling, landscaping, site improvements,  
29 equipment, extension or modification of campus utility  
30 systems, relocation of programs, and such expenses as may be  
31 necessary to complete the facility. This reappropriation is

1 in addition to funds previously appropriated.

2 Section 75. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof  
3 as may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2004,  
4 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in  
5 Article 4, Section 75 of Public Act 93-90, is reappropriated  
6 from the Capital Development Fund to the Board of Trustees of  
7 the University of Illinois to plan and construct a Classroom  
8 and Office Building at the Springfield Campus and related  
9 utility systems, including planning, land acquisition,  
10 demolition, construction, remodeling, landscaping, site  
11 improvements, equipment, extension or modification of campus  
12 utility systems, and such expenses as may be necessary to  
13 complete the facility. This reappropriation is in addition  
14 to funds previously appropriated.

15 Section 80. The sum of \$13,761,948, or so much thereof  
16 as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of  
17 business on June 30, 2004, from an appropriation heretofore  
18 made for such purpose in Article 4, Section 80 of Public Act  
19 93-90 is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to  
20 the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for all  
21 costs associated with the space needs of the Department of  
22 Natural Resources, Illinois Natural History Survey Division  
23 and State Water Survey Division on the campus of the  
24 University of Illinois in Champaign, including construction,  
25 capital facilities, planning, relocation, renovation and  
26 rehabilitation, mechanical systems, materials, services, and  
27 all other costs required to complete the work.

28 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
29 2004.
