## State of Illinois 2003 and 2004 SB3231

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$600,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Public Health for a grant to the Save A Life Foundation (SALF) for costs associated with the statewide implementation and expansion of SALF's program for training children in life-supporting first aid skills. Effective July 1, 2004.

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The sum of \$600,000, or so much of that amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Public Health for a grant to the Save A Life Foundation (SALF) for costs associated with the statewide implementation and expansion of SALF's program for training children in life-supporting first aid skills.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2004.
