

## 94TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2005 and 2006 HB0150

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/11-1427.5 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that a person under the age of 16 years may not operate an all-terrain vehicle with an engine larger than 90 cubic centimeters. Provides that the owner or person in possession of an all-terrain vehicle of that type may not knowingly permit a person under the age of 16 to operate it.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding Section 11-1427.5 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/11-1427.5 new)
- Sec. 11-1427.5. Adult-size all-terrain vehicles; operation
- 8 by persons under 16 prohibited.
- 9 (a) A person under the age of 16 years may not operate an
- 10 <u>all-terrain vehicle that has an engine larger than 90 cubic</u>
- 11 <u>centimeters.</u>
- 12 (b) The owner or person in possession of an all-terrain
- vehicle with an engine larger than 90 cubic centimeters may not
- knowingly permit a person under the age of 16 years to operate
- 15 <u>that vehicle.</u>
