## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

50 ILCS 705/10.7 new 30 ILCS 805/8.29 new

Amends the Illinois Police Training Act. Requires each police chief and deputy police chief to obtain at least 20 hours of training each year. Requires the training to be approved by the Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board and to concern certain topics. Provides that attending a conference held by an association that represents chiefs of police satisfies the training requirement. Requires the municipality to reimburse the police chief and deputy police chief for reasonable expenses incurred in obtaining the required training. Preempts home rule. Amends the State Mandates Act to require implementation without reimbursement by the State.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Police Training Act is amended by
adding Section 10.7 as follows:

6 (50 ILCS 705/10.7 new)

Sec. 10.7. Mandatory training; police chief and deputy
police chief.

(a) Each police chief and deputy police chief shall obtain 9 at least 20 hours of training each year. The training must be 10 approved by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards 11 Board and must be related to law enforcement, management or 12 executive development, or ethics. This requirement may be 13 14 satisfied by attending a conference held by an association that 15 represents chiefs of police. Any police chief and any deputy police chief, upon presentation of a certificate of completion 16 17 from the person or entity conducting the training, shall be reimbursed by the municipality for his or her reasonable 18 19 expenses in obtaining the training required under this Section. (b) Units of local government, including home rule units, 20 may not regulate the training of police chiefs and deputy 21 22 police chiefs in a manner less restrictive than the regulation by the State of the training of police chiefs and deputy police 23 chiefs under this Section. This Section is a limitation under 24 subsection (i) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois 25 26 Constitution on the concurrent exercise by home rule units of powers and functions exercised by the State. 27

28 Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding 29 Section 8.29 as follows:

2	of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the
