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1 AN ACT concerning law enforcement.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Police Training Act is amended by adding Section 10.7 as follows:
- 6 (50 ILCS 705/10.7 new)
- Sec. 10.7. Mandatory training; police chief and deputy

 police chief.
- (a) Each police chief and deputy police chief shall obtain 9 at least 20 hours of training each year. The training must be 10 approved by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards 11 Board and must be related to law enforcement, management or 12 executive development, or ethics. This requirement may be 13 14 satisfied by attending a conference held by an association that 15 represents chiefs of police. Any police chief and any deputy police chief, upon presentation of a certificate of completion 16 17 from the person or entity conducting the training, shall be reimbursed by the municipality for his or her reasonable 18 19 expenses in obtaining the training required under this Section.
 - (b) Units of local government, including home rule units, may not regulate the training of police chiefs and deputy police chiefs in a manner less restrictive than the regulation by the State of the training of police chiefs and deputy police chiefs under this Section. This Section is a limitation under subsection (i) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution on the concurrent exercise by home rule units of powers and functions exercised by the State.
- 28 (c) This Section does not apply to the City of Chicago.
- Section 90. The State Mandates Act is amended by adding Section 8.29 as follows:

- 2 Sec. 8.29. Exempt mandate. Notwithstanding Sections 6 and 8
- 3 of this Act, no reimbursement by the State is required for the
- 4 implementation of any mandate created by this amendatory Act of
