SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 65/13.1

from Ch. 38, par. 83-13.1

Amends the Firearm Owners Identification Card Act. Prohibits home rule units from regulating the acquisition, possession, or transfer of firearm ammunition legally purchased or possessed under State and federal law. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning safety.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Firearm Owners Identification Card Act is 5 amended by changing Section 13.1 as follows:

6 (430 ILCS 65/13.1) (from Ch. 38, par. 83-13.1)

7 Sec. 13.1. Local regulation of firearms and firearm 8 ammunition.

The provisions of any ordinance enacted by any (a) 9 municipality that which requires registration or imposes 10 greater restrictions or limitations on the acquisition, 11 possession, and transfer of firearms than are imposed by this 12 Act, are not invalidated or affected by this Act. 13 This subsection does not apply to the regulation of firearm 14 15 ammunition legally purchased or possessed under State and federal law. 16

17 (b) The regulation of the acquisition, possession, and transfer of firearm ammunition is an exclusive power and 18 19 function of the State. A unit of local government, including a home rule unit, may not regulate the acquisition, possession, 20 or transfer of firearm ammunition legally purchased or 21 possessed under State and federal law. This subsection (b) is a 22 denial and limitation of home rule powers and functions under 23 subsection (h) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois 24 25 Constitution.
