New Act

Creates the Agency Appropriation Act. Provides that an appropriation bill introduced in and passed by the General Assembly shall contain appropriations to no more than one State department, State agency, or other entity of State government.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning appropriation bills.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Agency Appropriation Act.
- Section 5. Separate appropriation bills. An appropriation bill introduced in and passed by the General Assembly shall contain appropriations to no more than one State department,
- 9 State agency, or other entity of State government.
- 10 Appropriations to each State department, State agency, or other
- 11 entity of State government shall be contained in separate bills
- introduced in and passed by the General Assembly.
