SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/5-5.25 new

Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code in relation to Medicaid. Requires the Department of Public Aid to reimburse advance practice nurses for mental health services they provide, as authorized by Illinois law, to Medicaid recipients. Requires the Department of Public Aid to develop a method to reimburse providers for mental health services provided by telemedicine. Effective immediately.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT in relation to health care.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by adding Section 5-5.25 as follows:
- 6 (305 ILCS 5/5-5.25 new)
- 7 Sec. 5-5.25. Access to mental health services. The General Assembly finds that providing access to mental health services 8 in a timely manner will improve the quality of life for persons 9 suffering from mental illness and will contain health care 10 costs by avoiding the need for more costly inpatient 11 hospitalization. The Illinois Department shall reimburse 12 advance practice nurses for mental health services they 13 provide, as authorized by Illinois law, to recipients. The 14 15 Illinois Department, by rule, shall develop a method to reimburse providers for mental health services provided by 16 telemedicine. The reimbursement methodology for mental health 17 services provided by telemedicine shall be comparable to the 18 19 reimbursement methodology used by the Illinois Department for 20 other services provided by telemedicine.
- 21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 22 becoming law.
