1 AN ACT concerning business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the
- 5 Military Surplus Identification Act.
- 6 Section 5. Military surplus; identification. Military 7 surplus sold on or after the effective date of this Act, must display an indelible and permanent marking designed and 8 approved by the Department of Military Affairs, by rule, 9 clearly indicating it was sold as military surplus. The 10 11 Department of Military Affairs shall determine the location of 12 the markings on the items. "Military surplus" means vehicles from the Vietnam conflict era or later. 13
- 14 Section 10. Penalty.

- (a) A person who sells military surplus without the indelible and permanent marking required by this Act is guilty of a petty offense. Each item sold is a separate offense. The penalty is a fine of \$1,000 for each offense. A tenth or subsequent offense is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 20 (b) A person who removes or obscures an indelible and 21 permanent marking on military surplus required by this Act is 22 guilty of a petty offense. Each item sold is a separate 23 offense. The penalty is a fine of \$1,000 for each offense. A 24 tenth or subsequent offense is a Class A misdemeanor.
