## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/12-611

from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 12-611

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that a violation of the provision prohibiting excessive sound amplification is a Class B misdemeanor.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
- 5 Section 12-611 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/12-611) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 12-611)
- 7 Sec. 12-611. Excessive sound amplification.
- 8 <u>(a)</u> No driver of any motor vehicle within this State shall
- 9 operate or permit operation of any sound amplification system
- 10 which can be heard outside the vehicle from 75 or more feet
- 11 when the vehicle is being operated upon a highway, unless such
- 12 system is being operated to request assistance or warn of a
- 13 hazardous situation.
- 14 <u>(b)</u> This Section does not apply to authorized emergency
- vehicles.
- 16 (c) Any violation of the provisions of this Section is a
- 17 <u>Class B misdemeanor</u> shall be a petty offense punishable by a
- 18 fine not to exceed \$50.
