Amends the Township Code. Gives township electors power to regulate or prohibit poultry running at large.

1 AN ACT concerning townships.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Township Code is amended by changing Section
- 5 30-95 as follows:
- 6 (60 ILCS 1/30-95)
- 7 Sec. 30-95. Livestock running at large. The electors may
- 8 restrain, regulate, or prohibit the running at large of
- 9 <u>poultry</u>, cattle, horses, mules, asses, swine, sheep, or goats
- 10 and may determine the time and manner in which those animals
- 11 may go at large, unless they are restrained from running at
- 12 large in some manner provided by law.
