SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 5/11-15.1-2.1

from Ch. 24, par. 11-15.1-2.1

Amends the Illinois Municipal Code. Requires that the parties to an annexation agreement in any county own or control all property that would make the property that is the subject of the agreement contiguous to the annexing municipality in order for the annexed property to be subject to the ordinances, control, and jurisdiction of the municipality (now, this requirement applies only to certain counties). Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly: 3

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by 5 changing Section 11-15.1-2.1 as follows:
- (65 ILCS 5/11-15.1-2.1) (from Ch. 24, par. 11-15.1-2.1) 6
- 7 11-15.1-2.1. Annexation agreement; 8 jurisdiction.
 - (a) Property that is the subject of an annexation agreement adopted under this Division is subject to the ordinances, control, and jurisdiction of the annexing municipality in all respects the same as property that lies within the annexing municipality's corporate limits.
- 14 (b) This Section shall not apply in \underline{any} (i) \underline{a} county with \underline{a} 15 population of more than 3,000,000, (ii) a county that borders a county with a population of more than 3,000,000 or (iii) a 16 17 county with a population of more than 246,000 according to the 1990 federal census and bordered by the Mississippi River, 18 19 unless the parties to the annexation agreement have, at the 20 time the agreement is signed, ownership or control of all 21 property that would make the property that is the subject of 22 the agreement contiguous to the annexing municipality, in which 23 case the property that is the subject of the annexation is subject to the ordinances, control, 24 agreement 25 jurisdiction of the municipality in all respects the same as 26 property owned by the municipality that lies within its 27 corporate limits.
