1 AN ACT concerning business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Hotel

 Bed Covering Posting Act.
- Section 5. Hotel. "Hotel" means any building or buildings
 maintained, advertised, and held out to the public to be a
 place where lodging is offered for consideration to travelers
 and guests. "Hotel" includes inns, motels, tourist homes or
 courts, and lodging homes.
- Section 10. Hotel bed covering posting. The operator of a hotel shall post or cause to be posted in each guest room of the hotel that he or she operates a sign indicating the date and time any bed covering in the guest room is changed. The sign shall be posted in a conspicuous location in the guest room. "Bed covering" includes quilts, blankets, sheets, and comforters.
- Section 15. Penalty. Any hotel operator who violates this

 Act shall be guilty of a petty offense, punishable by a fine

 not to exceed \$50 for each day of violation.
