9	Section 5. Hotel. "Hotel" means any building or buildings

12	and guests. "Hotel" includes inns, motels, tourist homes or
13	courts, and lodging homes.
14	Section 10. Hotel bed covering posting. The operator of a
15	hotel shall post or cause to be posted in each guest room of
16	the hotel that he or she operates a sign indicating the date
17	and time any bed covering in the guest room is changed. The
18	sign shall be posted in a conspicuous location in the guest
19	room. "Bed covering" includes quilts, blankets, sheets, and
20	comforters.

21 Section 15. Penalty. Any hotel operator who violates this

Act shall be guilty of a petty offense, punishable by a fine
not to exceed \$50 for each day of violation.".
